The recitalist will be Australian born Greg Abrahams who has recently performed in Chester, Birmingham, Hereford, Blackburn, Coventry and Bradford Cathedrals. He has also previously performed in Westminster Cathedral and twice at Westminster Abbey.

On the International circuit, Greg has performed in Slovakia, Notre Dame Paris, Washington National Cathedral, St Thomas 5th Avenue New York and Trinity Church Boston.

Later this year he returns to Australia to perform in St Mary's Cathedral Sydney. Greg has been resident in the UK for the past 29 years. He lives in Cheltenham and is organist and choir master at St Michael's Church in the village of Bishop's Cleeve on the northern side of Cheltenham. The choir has led the singing in services at Christ Church Oxford, Gloucester, Hereford, Worcester and Bristol Cathedrals. As well as holding professional music qualifications, Greg has a computer science degree, is a chartered engineer and his last 'proper job' was a University lecturer in Information Systems.
