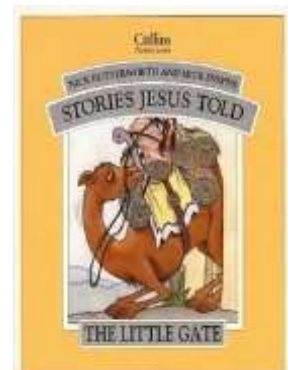
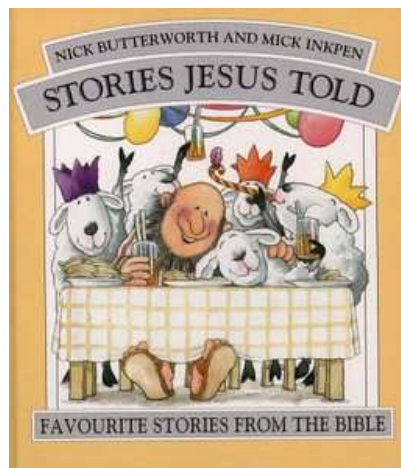
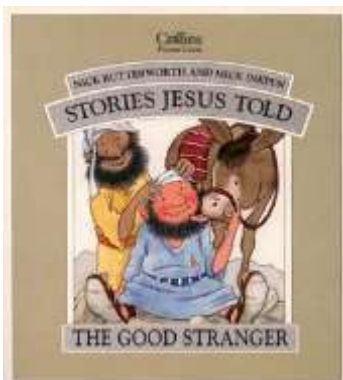

Using Books

You may be considering creating a “Story telling area”, with a special designated Storyteller’s chair , a few simple floor cushions and a small selection of books .Do not over clutter the area,present the books well and in a way that it’s easy for children to access them . Too many books and clutter distracts from the storytelling, the aim should be for a calm uncluttered space.

Secular Books

When choosing books remember that many secular books can also be used, such as “Guess, how much I love you” and “I’m Sorry” both by Sam McBratney, which give out a strong Christian message.

Many other similar books are available.



What to consider when creating a small story area.

Choose the right area in within your setting.

Does it look inviting and feel calm?

Present the books effectively.

Keep it clear of clutter.

Remember, children don't want old, worn books.
